The Religious Education Program for St. Matthew-St. Gregory the Great Parish assists parents in the ongoing spiritual formation of their children. Our program strives to nurture the development of the spiritual life of each student. We are dedicated to the youth and families of our community as we all continue to seek God's presence in prayer, participate in Mass, and receive the Sacraments while growing in love of God.

Parent Engagement

Families in Religious Education are encouraged to be an active part of our community through:

- Participating in Weekly Saturday Vigil or Sunday Mass
- Receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation Monthly
- Cultivating Family Prayer Time such as Grace before Meals, Morning and Night Time Prayers, Praying the Rosary, Reading the Bible, etc.
- Parent Meetings for Sacramental Preparation
- Family Events

Information will be sent home regarding meetings and events.

Attendance

Please call the CCD center to report any absence. Students are responsible to complete any missed work. If you know your child will have prolonged absence (due to illness or scheduling problems) please call in advance for the makeup assignments.

Electronic Devices

Cell phones must be turned off during class time. All other electronic devices (ipods, games, players, etc.) are not allowed in the classroom. Parents are asked to be sure students do not bring them to class.

Discipline Procedures

Students are expected to conduct themselves in a Christian manner while attending classes. If a student is unable to participate in religious education class without displaying *excessively disruptive* behavior, a parent will be notified.

Building Security Procedures

The front door will be locked at all times. All visitors must use the doorbell/intercom for entry. Students will be greeted at the door by a Religious Education Staff Member. Please be patient when dropping off or picking up outside of the normal class arrival and dismissal times.

Think First Stay Safe safety program required by the Archdiocese of Hartford will be presented to all students during the school year.

Traffic Control

The safety of our children is most important to us. We will begin dismissal with Grades 6-10 at 9:25am. They will be dismissed to the parking lot. For Grades 1-5, a parent must come into the Auditorium using the door by the parking lot to pick up their children a few minutes before class ends in order to escort their child safely to the car. When picking up your children, please park cars in the lot ONLY (not along the curb or in front of the building).
